Psalm 40:1-5

Verses 1 & 2 of this psalm help us understand \_\_\_\_\_ key \_\_\_\_\_.

1. When \_\_\_\_\_ causes us to get bogged down, we must \_\_\_\_\_ to God.  
Psalm 40:1

What the believer needs to do is just be \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ on God.

3. I prayed, God delivered = I must \_\_\_\_\_ to everyone.  
Psalm 40:5

God doesn't just bless us \_\_\_\_\_, He \_\_\_\_\_ his blessings to those who call on Him.  
Genesis 6:1
