James 2:14-19

Two key questions every \_\_\_\_\_ must \_\_\_\_\_.

1. What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? **James 2:14a**

Answer: It is \_\_\_\_\_.

Just saying you have faith is not \_\_\_\_\_ that \_\_\_\_\_ faith actually exists in you.

\_\_\_\_\_ does not indicate saving faith.

2. Can that faith save him? **James 2:14b**
