

**Kingdom Living in a Fallen World**  
**Prayer: The Heart of Man Aligning with the Will of God (Part 3)**  
**Matthew 6:9-15**

Jesus is teaching us to live and pray with respect, purpose, and humility.

**Our Father (v.9): He is the common bond of all true Christians.**

**Our – God is the Father of all who are in Christ.**

**John 1:12–13**

**Father – He is not an impersonal God, but a loving Father who cares for His children.**

**Romans 8:14–15; Galatians 4:4-7**

**In heaven (v.9): Our Father’s home is far superior to this earthly home we live in.**

**Because God is in heaven, all who call upon Him must be reverent in their words and actions.**

**Ecclesiastes 5:2**

**Because God is in heaven, we will be with Him one day in His home.**

**John 14:2–3**

**Hallowed be your name (v.9): Our Father’s name must be revered and honored.**

**Hallowed – God’s name is sacred and must be honored.**

**1 Timothy 4:4–5**

**Be your name: The name of God is above every other name and must be respected and honored.**

**Exodus 20:7**

**Your kingdom come (v.10): the kingdom of God has come in the person of Jesus Christ.**

**Presently, the kingdom of God resides in the hearts of all true believers – this is the prayer of evangelism.**

**Mark 4:26-28**

**The kingdom of God will be realized in heaven.**

**Mark 4:29**

**Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (v.10): God’s will is that His kingdom should grow and we must be a part of doing God’s will.**

**Your will be done on earth – true believers in Jesus, do the heavenly will of God on earth.**

**Matthew 12:49–50**

**True children of God involve themselves in their Father’s sovereign business.**

**Matthew 9:37–38; Daniel 4:34–35**

**Give us this day our daily bread (v.11): because we can only live \_\_\_\_\_ at a time.**

**Proverbs 30:8–9**

**Storing up for \_\_\_\_\_ causes many to trust in \_\_\_\_\_ rather than in God’s daily provision.**

**Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors (v.12):**
