

**Kingdom Living in a Fallen World**  
**Wisdom is Known by its Actions**  
**Matthew 7:24-29**

In Proverbs 9, we are also introduced to two builders whose names are \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ (fool).

Proverbs 9:1, 13-14

Wisdom and Folly built their houses in same locale: on the \_\_\_\_\_ in town.

Proverbs 9:3, 14

Wisdom and Folly not only have a \_\_\_\_\_, they both use the exact same words of \_\_\_\_\_: “Whoever is simple, let him turn in here! And to him who lacks sense she says,”

Proverbs 9:4, 16

Whatever similarities might exist between Wisdom and Folly, they are purely \_\_\_\_\_ since their \_\_\_\_\_ are so great.

We are told that Wisdom’s house has been built upon seven pillars: Seven is the number of \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_.

We are told nothing of the \_\_\_\_\_ of Folly’s house, leading us to conclude that there was no \_\_\_\_\_ foundation for it.

The foolish builder listens to the call of Folly and builds without any regard for Jesus’ \_\_\_\_\_ in the \_\_\_\_\_.

Only by \_\_\_\_\_ into the Beatitudes and building your life upon them will you have a house (life) that can stand the test.

Luke 6:46–48

Matthew 7:27
