

## Examining the Doctrine of Sanctification John 17:17

**“Sanctify them...”**

**Sanctify: To set apart from the \_\_\_\_\_ unto God**

**Types of sanctification:**

1. General (1 Cor. 7:14)
2. Christological (John 10:36 & 17:19)
3. \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Cor. 1:2)

**A work wholly of God whereby a person is made dead to the power of sin and made alive in Christ**

4. \_\_\_\_\_ (John 17:17)

**The process whereby a believer is more and more being set apart unto the Lord by putting off sin and putting on godliness**

5. Ultimate (Col. 1:22)

**“Sanctify them in the truth...”**

**How does sanctification happen?**

**-Through the \_\_\_\_\_ being imparted into the lives of Jesus followers**

**How is this truth imparted to Jesus followers?**

**-Through the gracious work of the \_\_\_\_\_ who has been sent by both the Father and Son**

**“...your word is truth.”**

**What is this truth?**

**-The truth is the word of God [the \_\_\_\_\_ word (Bible) which chiefly point us to the \_\_\_\_\_ Word (Jesus)]**

**The \_\_\_\_\_ is the means that the Holy Spirit uses to grow us by pointing us to both Christ and God’s commands**

**What is \_\_\_\_\_ needed for progressive sanctification?**

**-The \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ (together)**

*“They who are effectually called and regenerated, having a new heart and a new spirit created in them, are further sanctified, really and personally, through virtue of Christ’s death and resurrection, by His Word and His Spirit dwelling in them: the dominion of the whole body of sin is destroyed, and the several lusts thereof are more and more weakened and mortified; and they more and more quickened and strengthened in all saving graces, to the practice of true holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord.”*
