### Definitions

Faithful-dependable, \_\_\_\_\_, trustworthy, consistent

Faithless-is the opposite of faithful (an attribute of God-Exodus 34:6) and involves \_\_\_\_\_, a lack of loyalty, and a general unreliability

### Doctrine
