

**True Christians are Called to an Active Faith**  
**1 Peter 5:6-9**

The following five imperatives (admonitions) have four corresponding activities related to them.

Imperatives are words that describe what must be \_\_\_\_.

Humble yourselves (v. 6)

Casting all your anxieties on \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 7)

Be sober-minded (v. 8)

Be \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 8)
