**Peter, James, and John were eyewitnesses of the special revealing of the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ on the mountain.**

**2 Peter 1:17 Matthew 17:1-2**

**The voice of God, the Majestic Glory, overwhelmed those who heard it, but \_\_\_\_\_ came from Christ.**

**2 Peter 1:17 Matthew 17:3-8**

**There are three vital truths revealed by the voice of the Majestic Glory: the \_\_\_\_\_.**

1. “This is”: God’s declaration that Christ is the \_\_\_\_\_ One whom the Law and Prophets foretold.

2. “My beloved Son”: God’s declaration of the \_\_\_\_\_ presentation of the eternal Son of the Father.  
John 1:14     Colossians 1:19; 2:9
  
3. “With whom I am well pleased”: The only man to ever fully please God was the Son in \_\_\_\_\_.  
Jesus Christ lived for the \_\_\_\_\_ of making the Father known.  
John 14:7     John 12:27–28
  
- Jesus Christ pleased the Father by becoming the \_\_\_\_\_ for sinners.  
John 10:17     John 17:1–2

As eyewitnesses of the transfiguring of Christ and the voice of God, the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Apostles must be enough.     2 Peter 1:18

Two reasons why faithfully preaching the gospel is enough.

1. In the first advent, Christ came to fulfill the law, satisfy the Father, redeem \_\_\_\_\_ sinners, & destroy the last enemy, death: nothing else gives \_\_\_\_\_.  
2 Timothy 1:8-14
  
2. The second advent is drawing near: preaching the gospel \_\_\_\_\_ believers and \_\_\_\_\_ lost sinners to Christ as their only hope.  
Luke 12:35-40
