Chapter 6

<u>Verses 1-5-Main point:</u> Do not yourself into the debt of another (could be financial but really can be seen as referring to any sin-Matthew 5:23-26 & Romans 13:8a are parallel thoughts). If you do, be enough to go and quickly free yourself from that burden.		
<u>Application</u>		
1.	Be humble and as you read the text-think about how because of either your or your sin you have put yourself at the mercy of others (often our hard-heartedness or fear of man can lead us into this trap)	
2.	your sin and seek God's mercy in Christ	
3.	Re-read this passage now with in Christ	
4.	Pray asking God, in Christ's name, to you by the Spirit of Christ to walk in grateful obedience-asking for wisdom to our tongues and lives so that we do not fall into this trap but also asking for the grace of to get out of this trap when we have fallen into it.	
Verses 6-11-Main point: The man acts less responsible than an ant and will bring upon himself  Application:
